3. Vampires as Protagonists and Protectors - [Wildebeast](#)

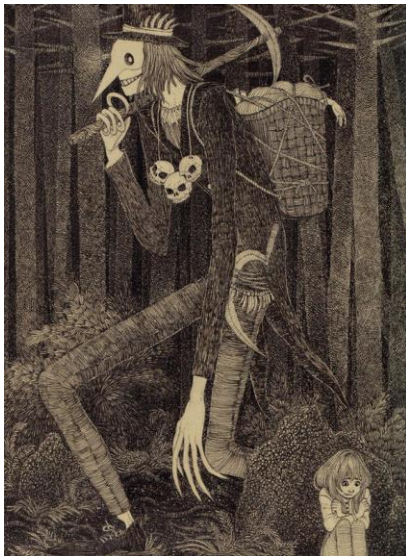
In contemporary fiction, vampires have transcended their traditional roles as antagonists to become protagonists and, in some cases, guardians of humanity. This shift explores the concept
